



LETTER TO THE PRESIDENTS AND SECRETARIES OF CLUBS

Dear Friends Presidents and Secretaries,

The first trimester of the rotarian year which corresponds to the vacation period for most of the countries of our district, has just finished. The numerous absences due to leave departures is finished, the meetings without grand interest due to the effectives too much reducted.

Like school children coming back from vacation all happy to turn the pages of new looks and see their fellow mates I engage all the members of your clubs under your impulse to start back the statutory meetings with more ardour, more pride and with a spirit reenforced with the rotarian friendship.

The vacation period has corresponded to the reflexion on the preoccupations of the clubs, this month has to be the beginning of the action and a good occasion is offered to all the clubs to make concrete realisations.

October is the month of professional action. Take advantage of this month already. For example the clubs that have taken the habit of starting "carrier" operations have to start over with them by getting more pupils involved and representatives of new professions. A new world of service is to be discovered in the field of the professional action by creating a new action for the promotion of the youth. For this purpose I recommend all the clubs to do one of the three following actions :

- R Y L A "Rotary Youth Leadership Awards".
- Training Camp for trained Personal.
- Rotarian Conference for students.

These three actions have for objectives to make known the respect and interest of the rotary for the youth, to encourage and help leaders of youth, and to recognize publicly the undoubtable qualities of the numerous young people who are rendering different services to their community as file-leaders.

For further informations on those programmes, please see to the manual of procedure, brochure n°693 and see the display of the youth.

The action to lead during this month of October therefore should not make you forget the other objectives of the rotarian year in progress mostly the increase of effective. For this purpose I draw your attention on the recommendations of the manual of procedure 1984 edition P.15 and 16 of the french version : it is desirable that the clubs adopt the habit of inviting the futur member to several regular meetings before having him sign an application card for admission.

To finish I will mark that my official visits started end September and will intensify in October. These visits are not services. They will be for the occasion of getting acquainted with all the members of the clubs in view to discover together a new world of service.

HOBBS member of the Whitby club, Ontario Canada ; governor candidat 1985-1986 and member of the "Polio 2005" Committee of the R.I. has been a sensitization tour on the possibilities of leading an anti-polio campain (by mouth) in several countries of the district 910 of the month of August to September.

He has stayed in Ivory Coast from August 22 to 28 and was welcomed by several responsables of the health questions : representatives of the WHO, the UNICEF, the Pasteur Institut and the Minister of public Health and the Population. # ENRAYER LE MAL D'ICI À L'AN 2.000

## Notre pays soutient la campagne du Rotary Club International

Le cadre d'un vaste programme antipoliomyélitique qui doit entrer en vigueur, le Rotary Club International, par le truchement de M. Kend Hobbs, délégué du comité de lutte contre cette afféction reçu jeudi dernier par M. Alphonse Djédjé Mady ministre de la Santé et de la population. Le ministre qui a loué la disponibilité du Club, a assuré M. Kend Hobbs du soutien que peut apporter pleinement à la réussite de ce programme dans notre pays.



Hobbs au ministre de la Santé Publique et de la population : sa contribution est primordiale pour la réussite de notre programme en Côte d'Ivoire.

Soulignant que le succès du programme dépend de l'engagement de toutes les parties concernées à savoir l'O.M.S. (Organisation Mondiale de la Santé), l'Unicef (Organisation des Nations Unies pour l'Enfance) et plus particulièrement le gouvernement hôte, M. Hobbs a déploré le fait que des milliers d'enfants à travers le monde souffrent ou meurent de la polio. «Le vœu du Rotary Club», dira-t-il «est d'aider les pays qui le désirent à enrayer le mal d'ici à l'an 2000». M. Hobbs pense que la disponibilité de l'Etat hôte constitue la clé du succès.

Il a en outre insisté sur le fait que la Rotary ne jouera qu'un rôle préventif grâce à une série de vaccinations pour les quatre premières années de la naissance. Mais, l'éradication totale du mal suppose le soutien des pays concernés et la poursuite du programme mis en place.

«Les gouvernements de ces pays doivent continuer l'action car elle est indispensable si l'on veut at-

teindre l'objectif qui est de ne plus avoir à parler de cette maladie d'ici à l'an 2000».

Le Rotary Club on le voit a déclaré la guerre à la poliomycérite.

### LES MÊMES AMBITIONS

Le ministre a, quant à lui, salué toutes les actions positives menées par la section Rotary-Club de Côte d'Ivoire. Il a par ailleurs fait remarquer que l'Etat ivoirien s'est déjà

attelée à une opération similaire. C'est le programme élargi de vaccination qui rejoint l'action humanitaire que veut mener le Rotary Club.

«Notre soutien» soulignera-t-il. «vous sera acquis dans la limite de nos possibilités. Sur les 26 secteurs de santé que comporte notre pays, 19 sont actuellement fonctionnels. Le nombre ira croissant au cours des prochaines années».

# LE ROTARY CLUB FAIT DON D'UN FORAGE A L'ECOLE DES SOURDS DE BOUKOKI


Le Rotary-Club de Niamey a fait don hier matin d'un forage à pédales à l'Ecole des sourds de Boukoki au cours d'une cérémonie présidée par le ministre de l'Hydraulique et de l'Environnement, le Dr Yahaya Tounkara. On notait également la présence du secrétaire général du ministère de la Santé publique et des Affaires sociales, du président du Rotary-Club de Niamey ainsi que du chef de District n° 2 et du serkin samari du quartier Boukoki.

Au cours de l'allocution qu'il a prononcée à cette occasion, le président du Rotary-Club de Niamey, M. Kaboré Alassane a déclaré que c'est un honneur et un réconfort pour les Rotariens de prouver une fois de plus leur attachement à l'idée du Rotary international qui est de servir...les démunis. C'est un témoignage supplémentaire de notre solidarité agissante, a-t-il souligné, après les dons de citermes de ravitaillement en eau aux populations d'Agadez et la construction de dortoirs destinés aux élèves de l'Ecole des aveugles.

Nous formulons le vœu que l'eau de ce forage puisse apporter des conditions de vie meilleures, en général pour toutes les populations de cette partie du quartier Boukoki.

De son côté, le serkin samari du quartier, M. Boubacar Djibo Maïga a loué l'esprit de solidarité qui a toujours caractérisé le Rotary-Club de Niamey avant de saluer le choix porté sur Boukoki quant à l'installation du forage. Il a ensuite rassuré l'assistance du bon usage qui sera fait de l'ouvrage qui leur est destiné et qui entre dans le cadre de nos préoccupations nationales.

Notons enfin que ce forage aménagé par la Société FORACO a coûté environ trois (3) millions de F.CFA et qu'il débite 3 mètres cubes d'eau par heure pour une profondeur de 62 mètres.

A/ - FLASH

Dear Governor,

Kindly mention this message in the monthly letter :

Beginning 1 July 1984, all contributions to The Rotary Foundation that are to be used to name a Paul Harris Fellow or to enroll a Paul Harris Sustaining Member must be so designated at the time the contribution is made.

Previously, clubs were allowed to apply contributions toward Paul Harris recognitions within 12 months after giving. Note : such an applied contributions made before 1 July, 1984, can still be used by clubs for Paul Harris Fellows and Sustaining Members, provided this is done within the prescribed 12-month period.

B/ - COUNSEL

I am herebelow sending you some important informations extract from the decisions taken on Mai 15, 1984 at Boca Raton by the central Counsel.

1°/ Designation of the Vice-President of the R.I. in 1984-1985

The central Counsel has approved the choice of Clifford L. Dochterman, of the Rotary Club of North Stockholm, California, E.U., to the functions of the Vice-President of the Rotary International for the rotarian exercice 1984-1985, done by the President conformably to the 5th article line 1 (6) of the interior regulation of the R.I.

2°/ Internal Expansion

President Canseco has taken into account his aim to reach a million members of Rotary Clubs from now to the end of December 1984 and the necessity of having the help of all the rotarians to realize this aim. The central counsel has engaged itself to make it reality.

3°/ Commemoration of the anniversary of the rotary and of the day of the "Entente mondiale" and of Peace.

The clubs are encouraged to commemorate in the adequate way and each one according to his customs on February 23, 1985 the 80th anniversary of the creation of the Rotary and of the day of the action of World Public Interest of the 3-H Programme (Health, Hunger and Dignity of man) of the Rotary Foundation and its other project.
